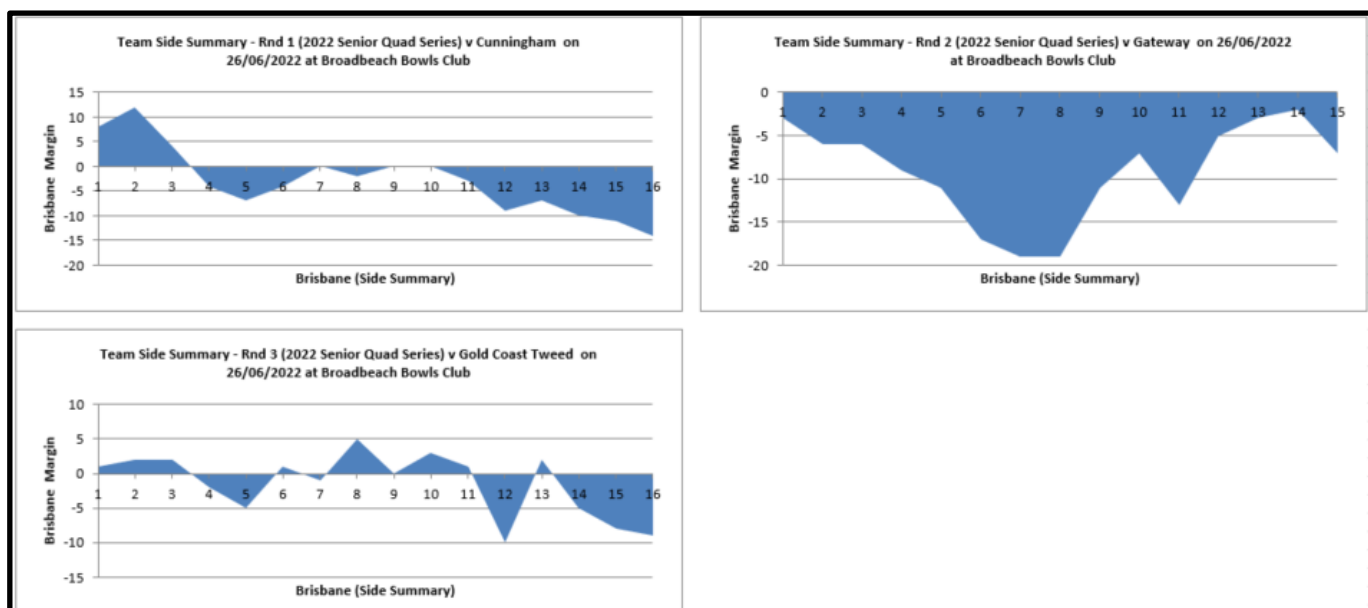

Selector's Comments

This series was held at Broadbeach on June 26, 2022 on perfect greens and weather conditions.

Selections for the series was marred by a conflict with the District Fours COC event which robbed us of 2 quality skips and at least 3 other players. It is hoped that in future the District calendar can be flexible enough to alleviate any conflict with Representative events.

Player unavailability became a problem, losing a senior skip and 2 players within 48 hours of the event. A communication problem meant we arrived at Broadbeach 1 player short. Geoff Manser filled in admirably and Lyn Fryer was co-opted to being Manager for the day. Her efficient efforts probably cost her husband this job at future events.

The end result of the day was 3 losses - to Cunningham, Gateway then Gold Coast - which was disappointing but probably not unexpected, after the numerous team changes and disruption in the preceding week.

Consistently, we started poorly and against the Gold Coast, the last half hour cost us a win. Not sure if this is fitness or due to many inexperienced players losing concentration at the end of a long day when the opposition applied pressure, but we need to address the motivational and mental aspects of competing at this level.

All players are to be commended for their reliability, application and team spirit. The team led by RVH was a standout for us, winning 2 matches and losing the last narrowly. Geoff Ellison at lead and Roger Connolly at 2 provided Russell with excellent opportunities to win ends.

Looking forward, our next event is in September and hopefully with all eligible players being available, we can return to our winning ways. Prior to this event I hope to have at least 1 morning of trial/practice session to provide some team cohesion before game day.
