#### Selector's Comments

This event was hosted on carpet at Pine Rivers Bowls Club and played in four teams of Fours against Cunningham, Sunshine Coast and Moreton Bay Districts. The format was 16 ends or 2.5 hours.

Selection for the team was made on August 28 after a trial at Ferny Grove.

Jim Wise and Greg Rolls were unavailable for the event due to a clash with State duties. This gave us an opportunity to bring in some new players. We congratulate these two players on their achievement hope next year to offer more players for Queensland selection.

We lost our first game against Moreton although we won 2 of 4 rinks. Third rink was close but one rink was a solid margin loss on a very windy ditch rink and it ruined our overall score.

We won comfortably against Cunningham and Sunshine Coast easing us into second position for the day overall. Comparing this result to our last outing at Gold Coast shows the importance of starting our matches better prepared and all players ready to perform from first to last bowl.

Joe Blasczyk came as a volunteer reserve, but the selectors were unable to find him a spot as all players remained fit and performing to expectations. The idea of having a reserve is great, but becomes very difficult to change a team that the skips are happy with and players are performing well. If we persist with the selection of a reserve in the future, consider selecting this reserve in a designated team at least for one game prior to the event.

The idea of a selection/availability trial also needs to be re-visited. While it provided players from clubs with an opportunity to perform in front of selectors and it gave players a chance to network with fellow team members, the importance of the trial was not supported by BDBA management who ruled it as a non-compulsory and unimportant BDBA occurrence. BDBA Trials can no longer be recognised as a valid reason for players to defer or postpone club championship matches. Therefore trials must be reconsidered as to their validity.

The Senior players thank Pine Rivers Club, for their hospitality and excellent catering. I would like to thank Ryan Burdett who went out of his way to be of assistance all day.
